Dr. Ghidini worked part time at Great Neck Women's Medical Care in the 1990's when he was a Fellow in Genetics and Maternal Fetal Medicine at the Mt Sinai Hospital and the world leaders in Maternal Fetal Medicine – physicians Richard L. Berkowitz, MD FACOG, Manuel Alvarez, MD FACOG, Charles Lockwood, MD, FACOG and Lauren Lynch, MD FACOG.

When he was a post-doctoral fellow at the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Yale School of Medicine prior to joining the Mt. Sinai Group, he was a world expert in Obstetrical Ultrasound and co-authored the book "Prenatal Diagnosis of Congenital Anomalies" by Roberto Romero, MD, FACOG, Gianluigi Pilu, MD FACOG, Philippe Jeanty, MD FACOG, Alessandro Ghidini, MD FACOG and John C. Hobbins, MD FACOG. The book was considered at the time the "Bible" or main reference for Obstetrical Ultrasound anomalies.
